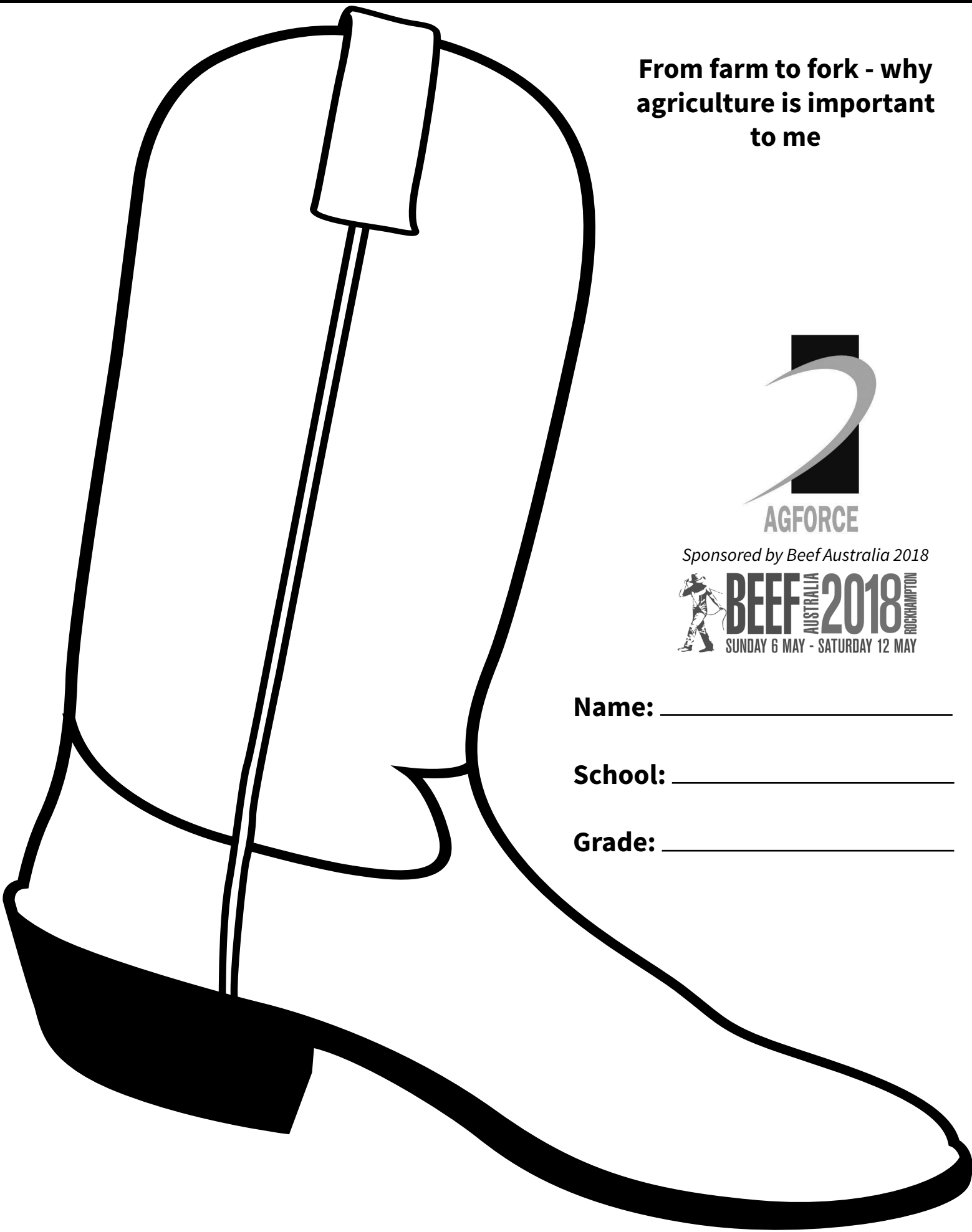

Judging

Students' artwork will be judged by representatives of AgForce and BEEF Australia. Beef boot artwork will be judged on the following criteria:

- Relationship of the beef boot creation to agriculture;
- Visual design, innovation, creativity and originality.

Beef Boot Prizes:

Beef Boot is open to children who currently in primary school with great prizes to be won within each of the 3 age categories (Prep - Grade 1, Grades 2-3 and Grade 4-6. Prizes are sponsored and donated by BEEF Australia 2018. Prizes will be announced closer to the date via the Open The Gate: AgForce Queensland School to Industry Partnership Program Facebook page.

Terms & Conditions

1. Information on "how to enter" and the prizes form part of these terms and conditions of entry. Entries not completed in accordance with these terms and conditions will not be considered;
2. Competition winners will be notified by mail or telephone and their names may be published on the AgForce Website and in AgForce publications;
3. Only Australian residents are eligible to enter;
4. The promoter is AgForce Queensland, Level 2, 110 Mary Street, Brisbane Qld;
5. The Promoter is not liable for lost, late or misdirected mail;
6. Entry to the competition is free. Entries must be accompanied by a completed competition entry form;
7. The winner will receive the prize stated in the competition information in which they entered;
8. Winners of the prize must make arrangements directly with the promoter for the collection or delivery of the prize;
