

Beef Australia 2018 Young Chef Competition

1. Information on how to enter, competition guidelines and prizes all from part of these terms and conditions.
2. Entries close on Friday 2nd March, 2018 5.00pm AEST. Entries must be submitted online via the form on this website.
3. To enter the **Beef Australia 2018 Young Chef Ambassador Competition**, you must:
 - a. Be working as an apprentice or qualified chef in Australia
 - b. Be able to attend Beef Australia in Rockhampton for a period of 3 days between 6th – 12th May, 2018.
 - c. Aged between 16 - 27 years as at 2nd March, 2018
 - d. Have your employer complete the consent & information form
4. Employees of Beef Australia and their immediate families are ineligible to enter.
5. The judging panel will review all nominations and select 10 finalists, these dishes will be replicated by a nominated Celebrity Chef and presented to the judging panel.
6. The chefs' dish which has received the most points will be awarded the winning prizes.
7. The total prize pool is valued over **\$7,000**. Flights, accommodation and event tickets will be supplied by Beef Australia. All prizes are not transferable for cash.
8. All nominations and supporting materials become the property of Beef Australia and will not be returned.
9. By entering the competition, each entrant agrees that all intellectual property rights in any recipe created by the entrant will vest in Beef Australia from the date of its creation. Beef Australia may use the recipe for its own commercial purposes and the entrant agrees not to object to any such use on the basis of any moral right.
10. By nominating to enter the competition, entrants acknowledge that if they are selected as the winner they may be asked to participate in publicity and promotion of the *Beef Australia 2018 Young Chef Competition*. Beef Australia may request their support in the form of comments for press releases, photographs, video, media interviews, radio and television appearances.
11. By entering this competition, you agree to be subscribed to Hospitality Magazine electronic mail and communications.
12. Entrants warrant that any recipes created during the competition are their original work. If this is found to be false information the entrant will be disqualified from the competition.
13. Finalist will be notified on or before 5pm Friday 9th March
14. The winner of the *Beef Australia 2018 Young Chef Ambassador Competition* will be announced & notified 3pm Friday 16th March.
15. Beef Australia reserves the right to refuse to allow a competitor to take part in any or all aspects of the competition, if Beef Australia determines, in its absolute discretion, that an entrant is not suitable.
16. The decision of the Judging panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Competition Rules

Submit your most inspirational Australian Beef dish for your chance to become the Beef Australia 2018 Young Chef Ambassador. As the winner, you will travel to Beef Australia 2018 held at Rockhampton QLD on agreed dates between 6th – 12th May 2018, for a period of 3 days. You will be inspired by cooking alongside leading chefs from around the globe in the Celebrity Chef Restaurant, experience innovative cooking techniques and participate in the true paddock to plate beef experience.

If you think you could be the *Beef Australia 2018 Young Chef Ambassador* then you need to nominate:

The competition begins with a simple nomination. Entries open on the 8th January 2018 and close on Friday 2nd March 2018. Go to www.beefaustralia.com.au and download the application form along with the employer consent form.

What to submit:

Your entry needs to be original, innovative and must only feature secondary cuts of beef, the recipe you submit must reflect your cooking style and food philosophy. Ingredients & metric quantities with methodology must be submitted with a high-resolution photograph of the plated dish to qualify as a successful submission.

What will the Judging Panel be looking for:

Modern techniques and trends with a range and level of technical skills while being creative when using a variety of secondary beef cuts, only secondary cuts to be used. Blends of texture, colour, taste, flavors and overall balance will be highly regarded. The dish methodology will be required to be precise in measurements and cooking timeframes. The judges may require you to cook the dish for tasting at their discretion.

What about my restaurant?

It is important that your entry is supported by your restaurant, café, hotel or bar. As a condition of entry your employer will be required to complete a consent form, they may also acknowledge your entry by a note on your menu, our Logo on your social media and website or a flyer on tables. If you are the Beef Australia 2018 Young Chef Ambassador your restaurant will win a UNOX Oven valued at \$1700.
