Boreelum

Your Hosts, Adam and Jacyntha Coffey welcome you to "Boreelum" for a full day tour, showcasing their 2,500ha beef breeding and trading enterprise, 15km South West of Miriam Vale.

Since purchasing 'Boreelum' 4 years ago, The Coffey's have focused on redeveloping approximately 400ha of failed 10-year-old hardwood plantation back to a productive beef enterprise. Through fencing subdivision, water reticulation and improving pastures they are now at a stage of a considerable uplift in carrying capacity.

Come and hear their story and partake in discussions around pasture and soil health, satellite monitoring, soil carbon projects, and supplementation for toxicity and methane reduction.

Adam and Jacyntha will talk about the exposure they have had to some incredible mentors over the years who have supported them to overcome many of the challenges they have faced and given them the incentive to make the most of every afforded opportunity. This commitment to continued learning and change has led to a range of experiences

with programs such as the Graeme Acton Beef Connections Mentor Program, Nuffield Australia Farming Scholarships, RCS Project Pioneer, the Marcus Oldham Leadership Course, The Lachlan Hughes Foundation and more. A representative from Advance Beef Leaders will be on site to speak on another exciting program for the beef industry.

The property tour will include a pasture walk with focus on soil health and legumes with Agrimix Pastures' Greg Campbell and Agriculture and Pastoral consultant, Ross Newman.

Cibo Labs will demonstrate how changes in ground cover have been monitored using satellite, Agriprove will present on the latest soil carbon projects, and Olsson's will discuss how supplementation can be used to support the health of both cattle and the environment.
